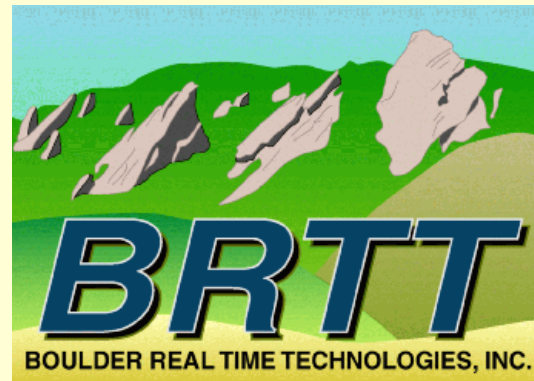

# rtgit

- Coupling of real-time systems with *git* content tracking
- Track Antelope real-time system configuration
  - Core debugging question: *“What Changed??”*
  - Help solve the *“Nothing Changed”* puzzle
- Rapidly redeploy systems on new machines
- Track stable and semi-stable files; don’t track “outputs” or “state”

# rtgit subcommands

- *rtgit init*
  - executed from within rtxexec(1) run directory
  - Zeroth-order setup
- *rtgit autoupdate*
  - Automatically run rtgit periodically
- *rtgit diffsince*
- *rtgit tarball*
- Standard *git* commands in the run directory
